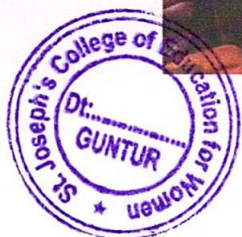
1. NAAC Orientation

4. Histrionic Talent Show

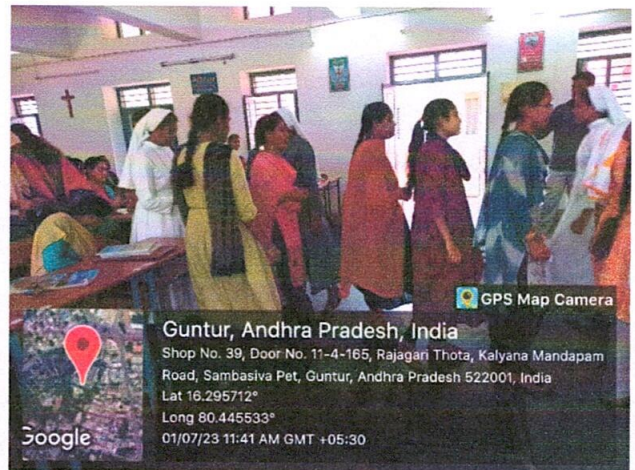
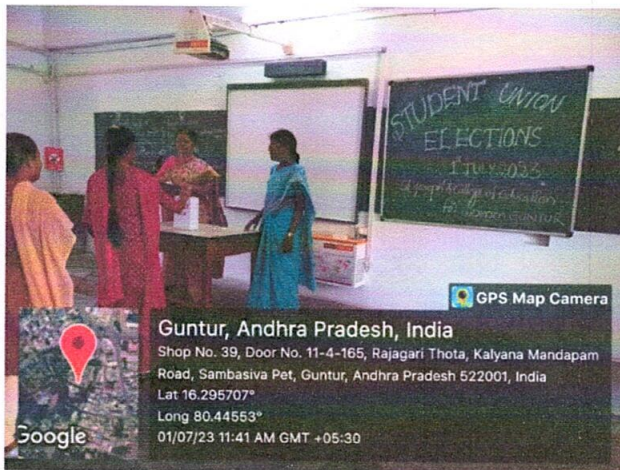

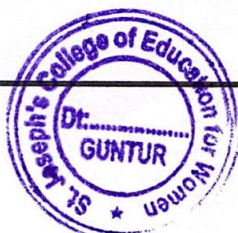
9. Inaugural Day Celebration:

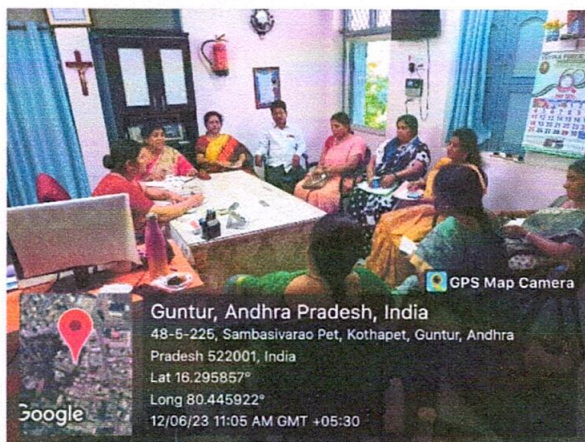
11. Career Skills and Opportunities in Research, Planning, Preparation and Strategies for DSC and TET

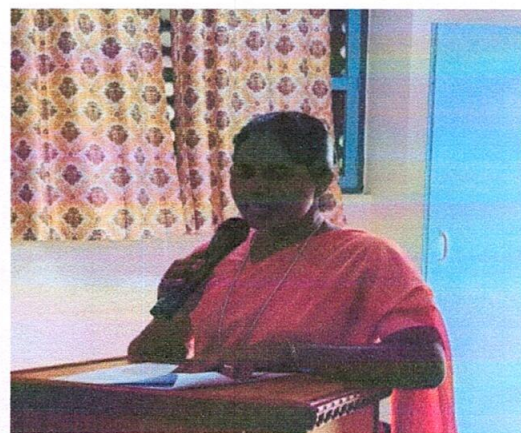
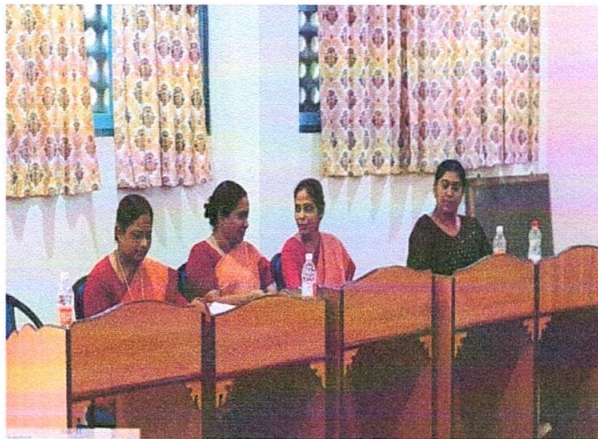

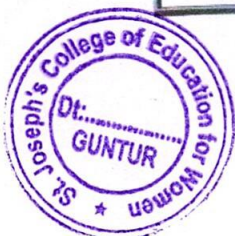
