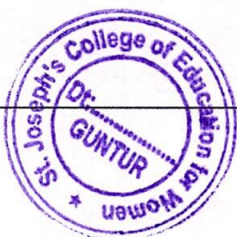

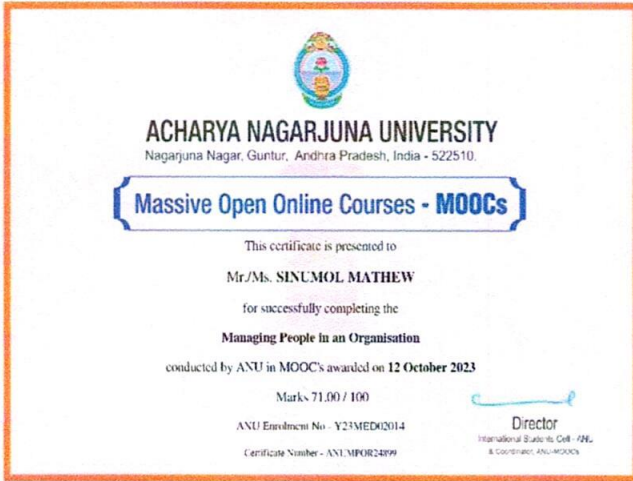



4. **For Advanced Learners:** Offer problem-solving tasks that involve real-world applications of congruency, such as architectural design or symmetry in art, to deepen understanding and challenge their critical thinking skills.
5. **For Students Needing Additional Support:** Provide step-by-step guided instruction, with simpler, scaffolded examples, using visual aids and templates to reinforce their foundational understanding before moving on to more complex problems.

These varied activities help create an inclusive learning environment, addressing the diverse needs of all students.

Introduction of Concept Attainment:-

Concept attainment is based on the attributes of a Jerome Bruner. It is an indirect instrumental strategy that use a structured inquiry process. In concept attainment, students figure out the attributes of a group or category that has already been formed by the teacher.

To do so, students compare and contrast examples that contain the attributes of the concepts with examples that do not contain those attributes. Concept attainment is designed to classify ideas and to introduce aspects of concept.

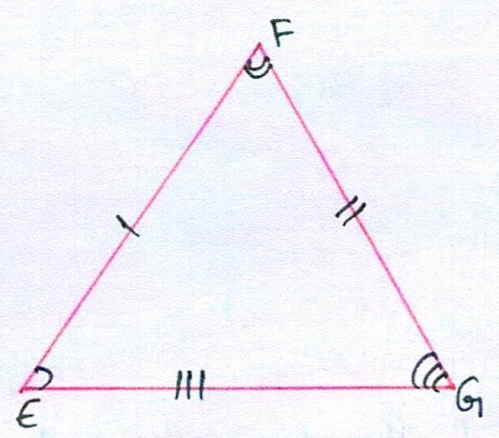
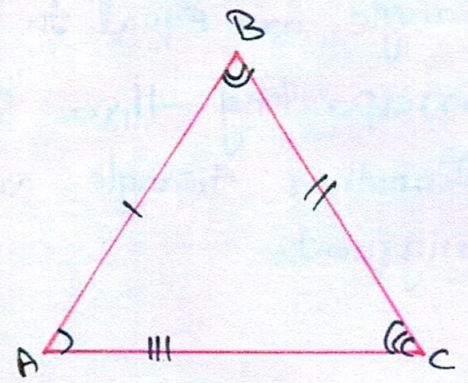
3. Congruency of Triangles
