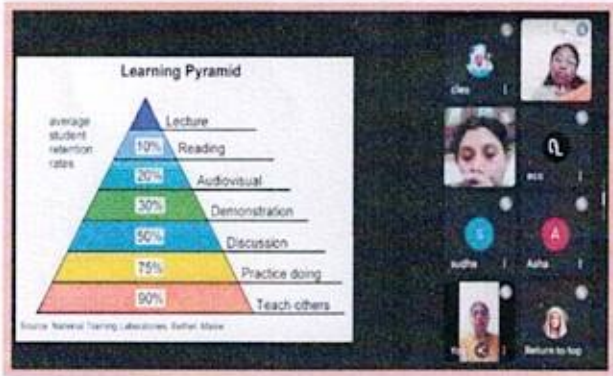
Google Classrooms created for each course are used to share resources that promote constructivist learning. Students also showcase their own creative resources on Google Classroom.
