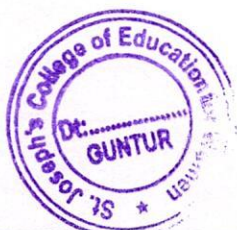

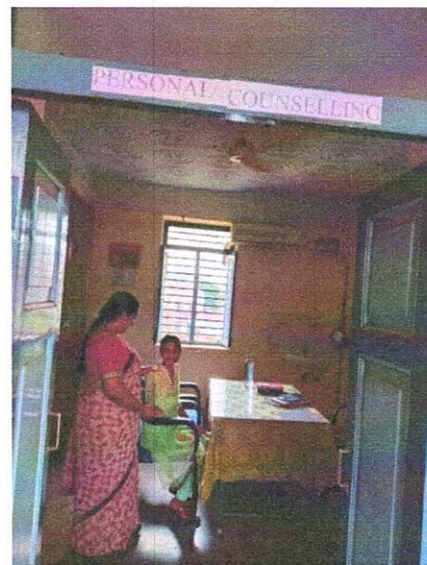
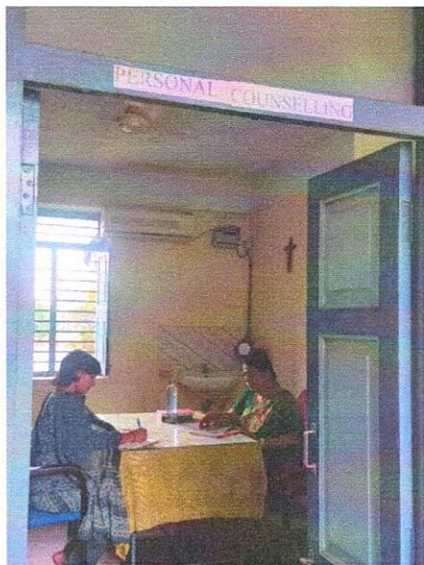
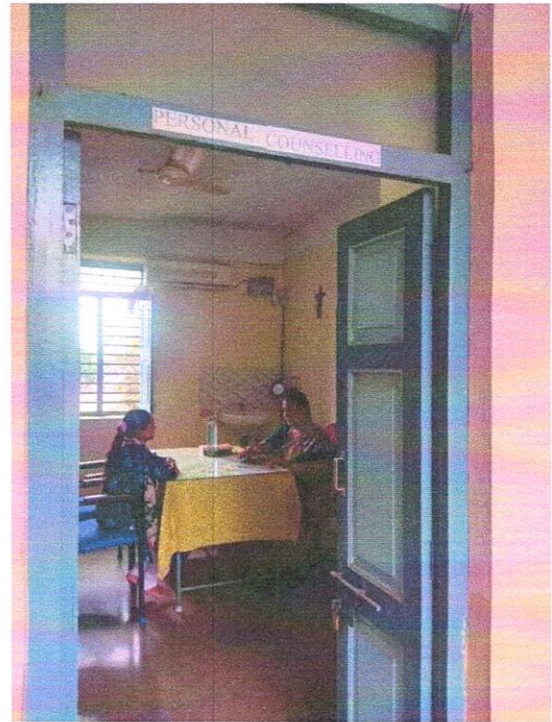
Issue: Family / Health

Republic Day Celebrations



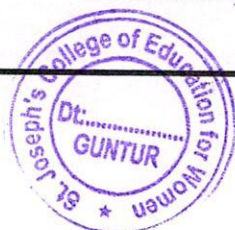



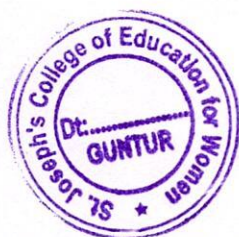



Seminar

A seminar is a structured event where individuals gather to discuss specific topics, exchange ideas, and gain knowledge from an expert or a group of experts. 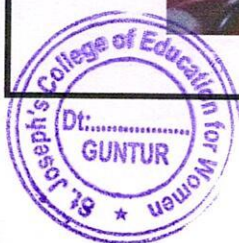
Research paper

Writing a research paper is a critical academic task that involves investigating a particular topic, analyzing information, and presenting findings in a structured and coherent manner. Whatever the role whether a student, scholar, or professional, mastering the art of research paper writing is essential.

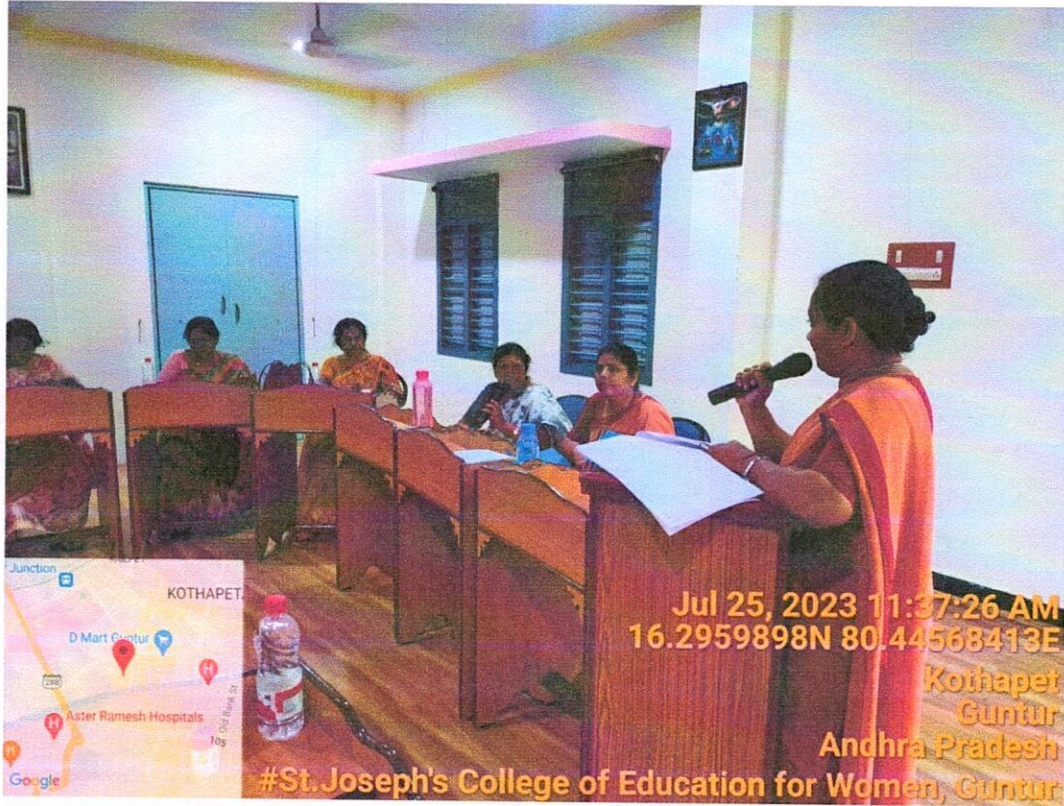
In preparation of a research paper, theory classes are conducted for the students by the faculty. Under the guidance of the research guide, a research proposal is prepared by the M. ED students. In this process, a sequential approach is followed as per the guidelines of the respective guides. It starts with the selection of the problem, preparation of the objectives followed by the hypothesis, variables, analysis and interpretation. Apart from the classroom activity of guidelines, a practical approach is followed as they go to the field and collect the data related to the research topic.

Once the students are done with their dissertation, they're asked to publish the essence of their research papers. Later they are assigned as teaching assistants to faculty engaged in research and development. The M.ED students act almost as a trained assistant to faculty in organizing webinars, seminars and workshops. By then they are competent and capable of downloading the relevant literature, administrative tests, and analyze the data accumulating experience in research related tasks. This whole activity is reaseach oriented preparation.

Seminars and research papers are both essential academic and professional tools, but they serve different purposes and are distinct in their format, delivery, and objectives.
