Students: The participants expressed their satisfaction with the organization and execution of the placement drive. They appreciated the opportunity to interact with multiple employers and gain insights.

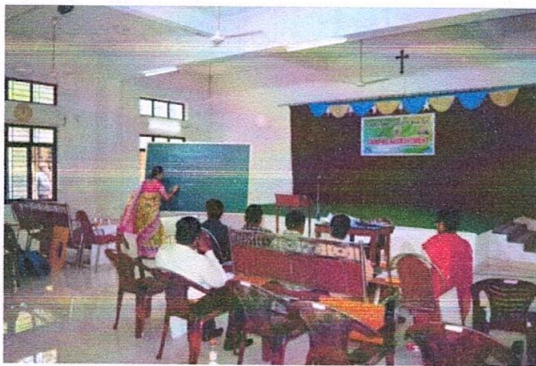
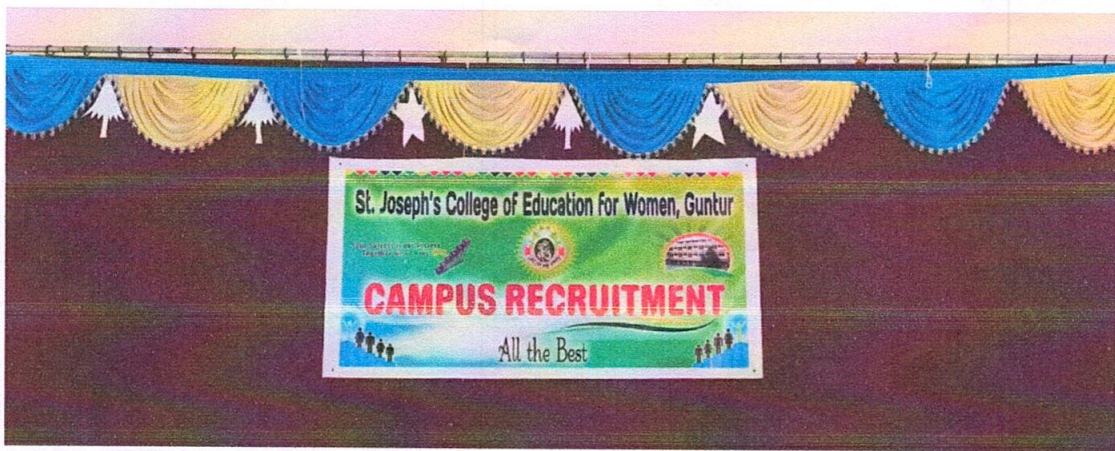
Institutions: The representatives from the participating institutions were impressed with the

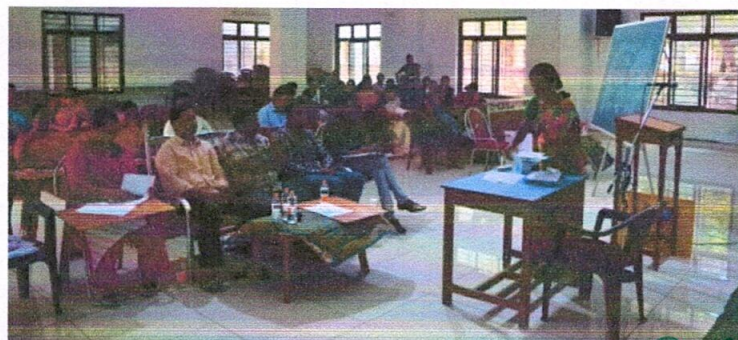

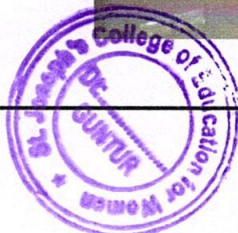
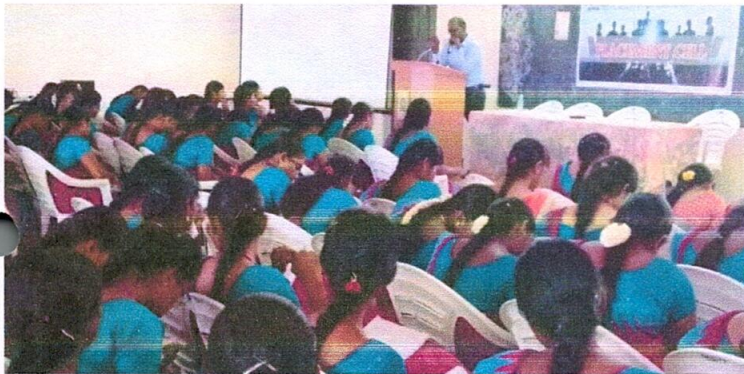
Details of placements in 2019-2020:
