Organization of Various Activities other than the Classroom Activities

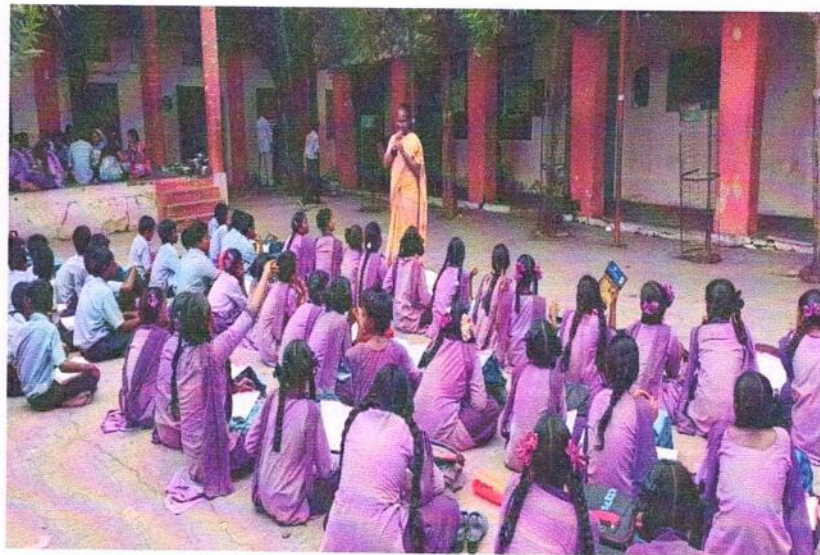

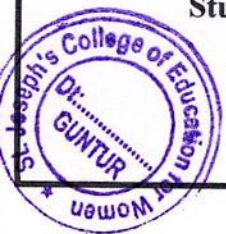
