- Right to get special care TO LIVE and for development in case of DISABLED CHILDREN



● Right to PLAY

**GOOD MEDICAL CARE**

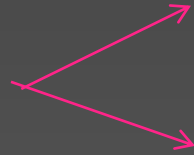


◎ Right to follow their RELIGION

# III. Prohibition of Child Marriage, Act 2006



**Child**



**MALE : > 21 YRS**

**FEMALE : > 18 YRS**



**CHILD MARRIAGE :**

**If the contract  
between any two  
people of which  
either one or both  
parties is a child**



# ACT:

- Two years punishment
  - Fine of one lakh rupess
- } ➤ Person who marries  
➤ Person who encourages, performs or directs

# MINORS:

**GIRL (maintainance by male upto 18 yrs)**

**BOY (maintainance by parents)**

# Disadvantages of Child Marriage

- ◉ Underage Pregnancy
- ◉ Provision for trafficking and sale of girls
- ◉ Increased abortions, premature births
- ◉ Handicapped child births or dead child births
- ◉ Obstacle for study
